The Loop doesn't cost anything.


The Loop is a trade. A Stranger for a Stranger.

The Loop serves the just and the wicked alike.






# STRUCTURE

The Loop is a web of interconnected stories; an anthology of murder, revenge, betrayal, redemption, heroism, and triumph.

Some stories will stretch to the end of the season and others will end in a single episode. Every tale will have a definitive beginning, middle, and end. All Loops must be closed.

The limited nature of this structure will allow us to collaborate with film actors for lead roles, such as Margaret Qualley or Ana de Armas for Calliope, Riz Ahmed or Christopher Abbott for Issac.

While each episode will feature stand alone crimes and character arcs, the arch plot of season one follows our anti-heroine, Calliope, as she searches for her lover's killer and fights to untangle herself from *The Loop*.

PARANOIA: Set during the first year of the COVID-19 pandemic, the city is alive with paranoia. Everyone is masked.

# NOIR

The Loop is a Tech-Noir Thriller, so it will be as hard-boiled as a 40s Noir, as gnarly as a 90s Thriller, but as colorful and bizarre as Blade Runner.

The Loop is not an homage to Noir.
Nor a period piece. Nor a love letter.

The Loop is a Noir in its truest sense.

The Loop confronts "Ordinary People"

forced to their last extremity. The Loop

interrogates these characters' Shadow Selves.

LOCATIONS -- Frequently, the uncanniness of these crimes will be underscored by their middle class settings. However, unlike the ladder of the law, which has a distinct top and bottom, *The Loop* is a circle: from the Trailer Park to Park Avenue, no one is safe.

# SEASON ONE SPINE

THE HOOK (EP.1 & 2)
WE BEGIN WITH "MURDER."

When Mourad is gunned down in the street, his family and friends grieve. Save for one. His step-daughter, Cheree. She has a Loop to close. A Stranger to kill.

Unable to complete the task, Cheree conscripts her admirer, Issac, into the deal.

Issac kills The Stranger in cold blood.

And has rarely seen a sober day since.

10 YEARS LATER

Issac is gunned down by a Stranger in the vestibule of his Queens apartment building.

His Killer leaves one witness: Issac's lover, Calliope.

We travel this bad road with her.

# SEASON ONE SPINE cont.

THE BUILD (Ep.3, 4, & 5)

WHO KILLED ISSAC?

After the Police try to railroad an innocent man, Calliope teams up with Issac's EX-CON/AA sponsor, Joe, to solve the mystery herself.

Using MAP TRACKING technology, they trace Issac's final days and discover that the man Calliope loved was far from what he seemed.

Calliope will see Ordinary People commit unspeakable crimes.

No one is who they appear to be.

No one can be trusted.

No one is safe.



THE PAYOFF (Ep.6)

Calliope uncovers the true horror of The Loop and its network of killers hiding in plain sight.

Issac's death was only the beginning...

The Loop will continue as long as there are characters with their backs to the wall.


As long as there is a person ready to destroy someone for money, or power, or love, there will be a Loop.
